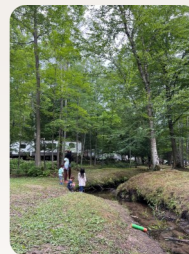

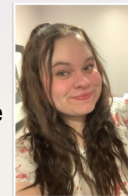
Although retired, Henry continues to use his gifts in preaching and teaching whenever the Lord provides opportunities, both in his home church and in other congregations.
